VETERINARY NURSE INITIATIVE UPDATE DECEMBER 2018

Background:

The "Veterinary Nurse Initiative" that NAVTA is working on here in Ohio is on the move again. The initiative's goal is to create a unified credentialing requirement, title, and scope of practice. This can help with issues from moving state to state, public recognition and other issues.

Here in Ohio we already have the gold standard for credentialing (graduate from AVMA approved school, pass the VTNE, maintain CE, and a Practice Act that defines our scope of practice). So the only thing we did not have was the name. NAVTA did a survey of possible names and registered veterinary nurse (RVN) was voted on and accepted as the name we should have.

Your OAVT board has voted to support of this initiative as well as the OVMA. Other clinics and businesses have also stepped up and shown support.

Ohio's VNI Timeline in 2018:

- <u>In February</u> the House Bill 501 (HB 501) was introduced to the House of Representatives and assigned to be presented to the Agricultural Committee. This bill is to only change our name.
- March 6th Rep. LaTourette and Huffman are the co-sponsors and presented the bill to the committee
- March 13th- A Representative from NAVTA, the President of OVMA, a Veterinarian from a Vet Tech Program in Ohio, an Ohio RVT instructor, and an Ohio RVT Program Director with a RN degree gave testimony on behave of the veterinary technicians of Ohio.
- March 20th The Ohio Nursing Association (ONA) gave testimony of opposition, an Ohio RVT gave testimony and answered questions after the ONA testimony.

ONA is claiming the "RN" applies to humans only, but we are asking for "RVN" which is not "RN". They are afraid it will dilute their profession and confuse the public. But RVNs would not work in human hospitals and RN's would not work in a veterinary clinic.

April 10th –The committee voted. 17 members present. 16 voted in favor with 1 against

Next step:

The bill was supposed to go the House floor to be voted on by all Representatives but due to change in the House leadership that was out of our control HB 501 has not made it to the floor for a vote.

We are waiting to hear on the date in which it will up for a vote. It is expected to be voted on before the New Year.

We usually only get a couple of days' notice before the vote. Once we receive a date we will once again ask Ohio RVT's for their support in letting their Representatives know that they support this bill.

SB 337:

Since the process has been slower than expected, the governmental team and NAVTA have introduced a "companion bill" to the Ohio Senate (same bill as HB 501 but with another bill number) this bill number is SB 337.

- November 21st the bill was introduced with Sen. Huffman, Bacon, Coley, and Wilson as co-sponsors of the bill.
- November 28th the bill was assigned to the Senate Agriculture Committee
- December 4th Sen. Huffman will provide testimony
- Next the committee will hear the same testimony from the veterinarians and veterinary technicians that spoke in support to the House of Representative Agricultural committee.
- Then another possible hearing is usually set for any opposition testimony or more testimony in support of the bill.
- The committee will then vote either that same day or at another meeting.
- If it passes it will go to the Senate floor for all Senators to vote.
- If it passes both the House and the Senate it will then go to the Governor for approval.

Update:

• <u>December 10th</u> - The Veterinary Nurse Initiative has passed the Ohio House - it now moves on to the Ohio Senate
