NAVTA has been working hard behind the scenes to ensure technicians are protected during this time of unprecedented change.

Letters were sent to all states in an effort to encourage essential listing for the veterinary field in those states that questioned the need to continue to open and operate as a community necessity.

Continuing education has also become a question mark for some states as many lectures and conferences have been cancelled.

NAVTA has made a push to the licensing boards to loosen up the requirements to allow time for accumulation of additional CE credit.

They have also recently worked hard in West Virginia to help stop a bill that was presented to eliminate the roll and title of the veterinary technician in their practices.

During these uncertain times it's nice to know we have a group of dedicated individuals we can turn to for help.

VETERINARY NURSE INITIATIVE

Due to unforeseen circumstances in our local government, as well as in the world, our Senate Bill for the Nursing Initiative has hit a stand still.

We have been unable to get the bill back into committee for a vote and have been unable to start the bill in the House due to the recent Covid-19 issues.
